

Fall 2015 General Assembly Scholarship Application

The Student Senate for California Community Colleges (SSCCC) has a limited number of scholarships available to help Associated Student Organizations participate in the biannual General Assembly. Scholarships will be awarded to selected Associated Student Organizations for the purpose of sending one delegate and one advisor. **Advisors serve as valuable resources for institutional memory and support throughout many years of different student leaders; we encourage scholarship recipients to send an advisor if availability and resources permit**, however one additional student representative may be sent in the place of an advisor. The Fall 2015 General Assembly will take place from November 13-15, 2015, at the Lions Gate Conference Center, 3410 Westover Street, Sacramento, CA 95652. These scholarships cover event registration fees (**not hotel or travel costs**). **You must register for the General Assembly by the Scholarship Application Deadline - Friday, October 23rd, 2015, 11:59pm.**

The deadline to apply for scholarships is Friday, October 23rd, 2015, 11:59pm. Applicants will be notified of the status of their application shortly after this date.

Please do not wait for the scholarship results to register. Payment is not due at the time of registration. If you are selected for a scholarship, your registration fees will be covered by the SSSCC. Again, the scholarship only covers registration fees – hotel and travel, as well as meals not covered by registration (Friday and Saturday dinner) are still the responsibility of the ASO to pay for. **In the event that your school is not chosen to receive a scholarship, you will be notified and will have the opportunity to cancel your registration.**

Criteria and Considerations:

1. Attach your Associated Student Organization's (ASO) approved budget for the 2014-2015 school year to the completed scholarship application.
2. Provide a detailed description within this application explaining your ASO's interest in attending the General Assembly.
Priority will be given to ASOs who have the greatest need.
3. A total of ten (10) scholarships are available.
