

### *Butte College Edition*

#### **Genesis of Butte College**

In the early 1960s, Chico State College was finding it difficult to meet the needs of a growing student population in Butte and Glenn Counties, and local students were commuting to Yuba College in Marysville.



#### **Future Home of Butte**

In January 1972, the construction of the 1.6 million gallon water tower, roads, utilities, and building pads marked the beginning of development at the permanent campus site.



#### **First Trustees**


In 1966, the founding members of the Butte Junior College District Board of Trustees were elected and in 1978 Randy Meeker becomes the first student trustee for Butte College.
