GROWING THROUGH RESILIENCY

In 2020, students faced a number of unprecedented challenges due to COVID-19 in addition to remote learning. However, community college students are resilient and these challenges provide an opportunity to grow. These workshops should provide students an opportunity to share their experiences and learn how to use their vulnerabilities, challenges, fears, and struggles to effectively cope with, or adapt to, stress and challenging life situations.



DEVELOPING AND FOSTERING STUDENT LEADERSHIP

The SSSCC integrates leadership training and networking opportunities for our students. Programs across the state support student leadership groups. These workshops will focus on how student leaders are developing themselves and the activities and strategies they are using on their campuses.

BEING A VOICE FOR CHANGE

The SSSCC is the official voice as recognized by the Board of Governors, legislature. These workshops should empower students to use their voice to influence policy, educate stakeholders, and inform constituents of those issues that impact higher education and students in particular.



ACCESSING RESOURCES FOR STUDENT SUCCESS



The SSSCC advocates for students experiencing housing insecurity, food insecurity, and a number of other challenges accessing basic needs that are critical to their success in higher education. Student leaders may be unaware of how to leverage resources on their campus to support their peers.

These workshops will share how student leaders can identify resources, communicate them throughout the campus, as well as how to increase access to resources for all students.
